DESCRIPTION

SYNOPSIS

- *CONVERSATION 1: The Purpose of Preaching*
Description: The purpose of preaching is not to teach people the Bible, but rather to teach the Bible to people. In this session, we'll discuss the purpose of preaching, how people take in information, the necessity of application, and the focus of each message.

- *CONVERSATION 2: Getting a Word from the Word*
Description: Every great message is a combination of helpful truth and engaging presentation. In this session, we'll examine how to uncover unique angles from ancient truths.
- *CONVERSATION 3: Crafting a Compelling Message*
Description: Every message should create a journey for the audience. How we construct a message determines if our content maintains interest and leads to transformative application. In this session, we'll cover the core elements of every great message, how to create transitions, and widening the message funnel to bring as many people along the journey as possible.
- *CONVERSATION 4: Developing a Series*
Description: Creating a message is complex. Stringing together a few messages around one idea can feel overwhelming. When we take the fundamental questions of individual message construction and add a strategic timeline, we can build a full message series.
- *CONVERSATION 5: Developing as a Presenter*
Description: The best message delivered poorly disengages those who need to hear it the most. In this session, we'll consider how to focus on connecting with our audience rather than remaining tethered to our content.
- *CONVERSATION 6: Preparing to Preach a Powerful Message*
Description: Anyone who makes something look easy has prepared well. Great preaching requires intentional preparation. In this session, we'll discuss ways to internalize the burden, rehearse for success, recapture our Saturday nights, and engage the Holy Spirit throughout the process.
